



Somerset County Mobile Food Bank 2025 Food Distributions

Receive food 2x a month from SCMFB distributions. Each family that qualifies for SCMFB food distributions can receive food both at a

Saturday distribution and at one of our weekday distributions. Families will receive a mixture of vegetables, fruits, frozen meats, and dry good items totaling around 45 pounds at each distribution. If you are already registered with SCMFB, bring your current Food Bank ID card, or if you are not, we can sign you up at any location that same day (*please bring an item providing your address*). All times are estimated and SCMFB will sometimes go past these times in order to get everyone served, we appreciate everyone's patience.

The goal of the Somerset County Mobile Food Bank is to provide additional fresh food items to low-income households of Somerset County even though they may be receiving assistance from the local food pantries, WIC, Food Stamps, etc.



Who qualifies for assistance?

That's easy: any household earning less than 185% of the Poverty Line.
